Context


The DPP is a game-changer for circularity and compliance

The concept of the DPP was first introduced by the EU with the aim of supporting the **circular economy and sustainability.**

The DPP is one facet of many regulations aimed at helping to deliver the **EU's sustainability goals.**

Not only in the EU, but the DPP concept is part of other regulations around the world.

Beyond the sustainability goal, the DPP is becoming a key point of **connection between brands and consumers.**



Regulatory context

The **ESPR** (Ecodesign for Sustainable Product Regulation) is the umbrella regulation of the DPP.



It's a new law that aims to make products in the EU more environmentally friendly – more durable, reusable, repairable, and recyclable.

The DPP is the **central digital pillar** of the ESPR and forms the basis for the digitalization of product information.

The DPP should be designed to work in harmony with other regulations and used beyond ESPR.





What is a digital product passport?



Collect and share product information across the product lifecycle



Digitally **store** data (in the cloud)



Provide **easy data access** through scannable data carriers (e.g., QR code)

The **DPP** is a vehicle of information that provides digital access to product-specific information on **sustainability**, **circularity**, **and legal compliance**.



Uncover and use hidden synergies

A single digital source replacing fragmented data & documentation silos-streamlining access for regulators, partners, and consumers. Early-stage data integration not only simplifies compliance but also empowers transparent, customer-facing communication.

Cosmetics regulations (EU / CSR / MoCRA)


Require disclosure of ingredients, safety assessments, and compliance by jurisdiction (EU, China, US).

REACH / SCIP (Chemicals)

Requires disclosure of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHCs) and submission to the SCIP database.

CE marking / product safety

Products with CE marks must include technical documentation to demonstrate safety and conformity.



AGEC law (France)

French circular economy law mandating repair index, environmental labelling, traceability, and digital info access.

Right to repair (EU directive)

Requires access to repair instructions, spare parts, and repair services for consumers and professionals.

PPWR (Packaging Waste Regulation)

Requires to include data on recyclability, material composition, and origin via a data carrier on packaging.

Repair

Extend product lifespan by restoring or replacing sub-components

Augmented products

- Provide additional product information
